# Jefferson County Forestland Classification Committee 2023 Decision Points (from 01-06-2023 meeting)

#### 1. Issue Paper #1 – Who Should do the initial mapping?

Alternative 2 chosen:

- a. ODF will produce the initial maps
- 2. Issue Paper #2 Mapping standards Polygon size

Alternative 2 chosen:

a. Limit mapping size to 5-acre polygons in areas that are surrounded by other classified lands.

#### 3. Issue Paper #3 – Mapping standards – Edge detail

Alternative 2 chosen:

a. Follow edges in a smooth and general manner. Committee will not determine a set scale.

#### 4. Issue Paper #4 – Rights-of-ways

Alternative 1 chosen:

a. Classify land within a Right of Way based upon site productivity and immediately adjacent land.

### 5. Issue Paper #5 – Dual Assessment

Alternative 1 chosen:

a. Continue to assess within Rural Fire Protection Districts

#### 6. Issue Paper #6 – Juniper Classification

Alternative 2 chosen:

a. Classify Juniper dominant stands as grazing land, class 3.

## 7. Issue Paper #7 – Agricultural and CRP lands

Alternative 2 chosen :

- a. All agricultural lands that are irrigated to prevent fire spread shall be exempt.
- b. CRP and wheat lands to be Class 3
